

GrowX Global Leases Additional 65 Acres for Hemp Production

Vancouver, British Columbia, October 4, 2019 - [GrowX Global Corp.](#), a producer and exporter of Cannabis and Hemp products based in Vancouver B.C., is pleased to announce that the company has entered into an agreement with a local farmer to lease 65 acres of fertile farmland in Mission BC for the cultivation and processing of hemp.

Under the terms of the Lease Agreement, GrowX will gain the right to cultivate hemp on the property for a period of 3 years. Cultivation will commence in Q2 2020 with first crop expected to harvest in Q3 2020 and bring the total to 85 Acres available for Hemp Cultivation, capable of producing 400 Kg of Hemp annually.

The leased property is located in Mission, B.C. and is within close proximity of the Company's current site and thus maintains the same ideal growing environment for quality hemp cultivation and processing.

Hemp is an important part of our strategy said Jas Basi, CEO. Having a license to produce hemp in advance of our license to produce Cannabis allows us to generate high margin operational cashflow that is easy to scale in response to demand.
